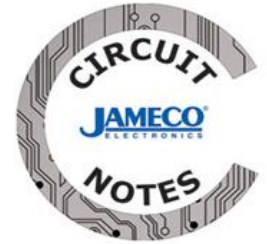


Arduino Uno
